a portrait  
Reality Project**

The daily, the ordinary, all the endless chores that everyone's existence is made of and of which no trace remains. This was the central point of interest of Janina Turek that fifty-seven years. This anonymous housewife from Krakow, left at her death more than seven hundred notebooks in which beautifully and with precision she organized the events of her life in the colossal work: how many phone calls at home she received who called (38,196); where and who she met by chance and greeted with a "hello" (23,397); how many gifts she gave, to whom and what kind (5,817), seen television programs (70,042), all noted without comment, without emotion.

Striking portrait of a female and traditional world, that, without escaping the fate of a crossroad, stands in the glare of a parallel history: through the careful confrontational game in the reportage by Mariusz Szczygiel we see the death of Stalin, the Fidel Castro visit to Krakow, the state of siege proclaimed in 1981 by General Jaruzelski without having these facts mentioned directly.
